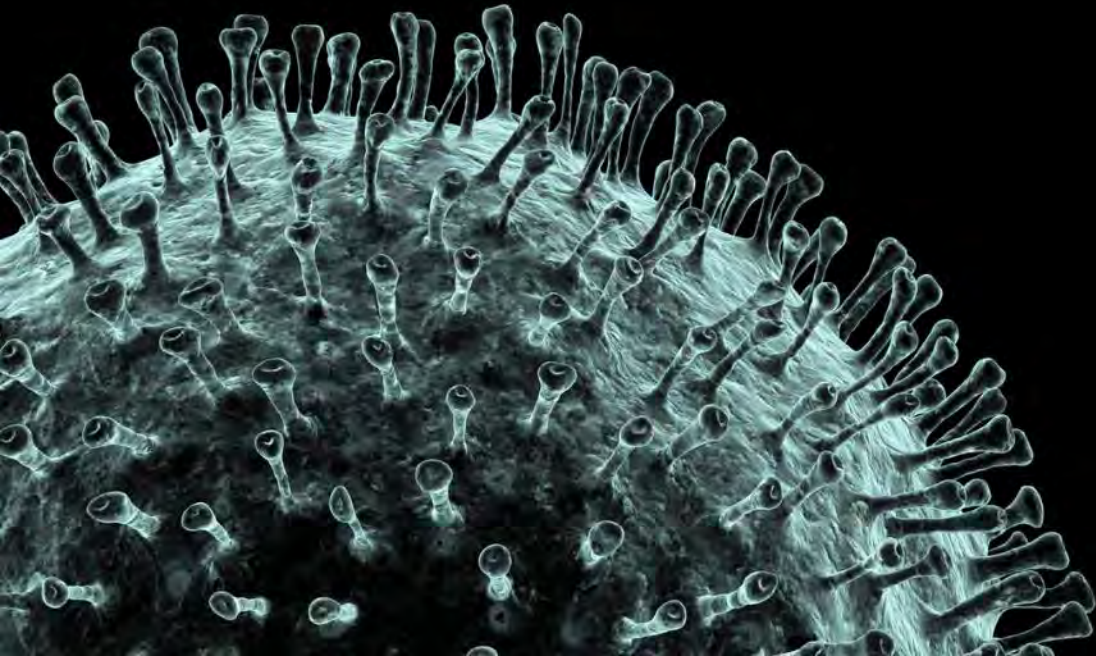

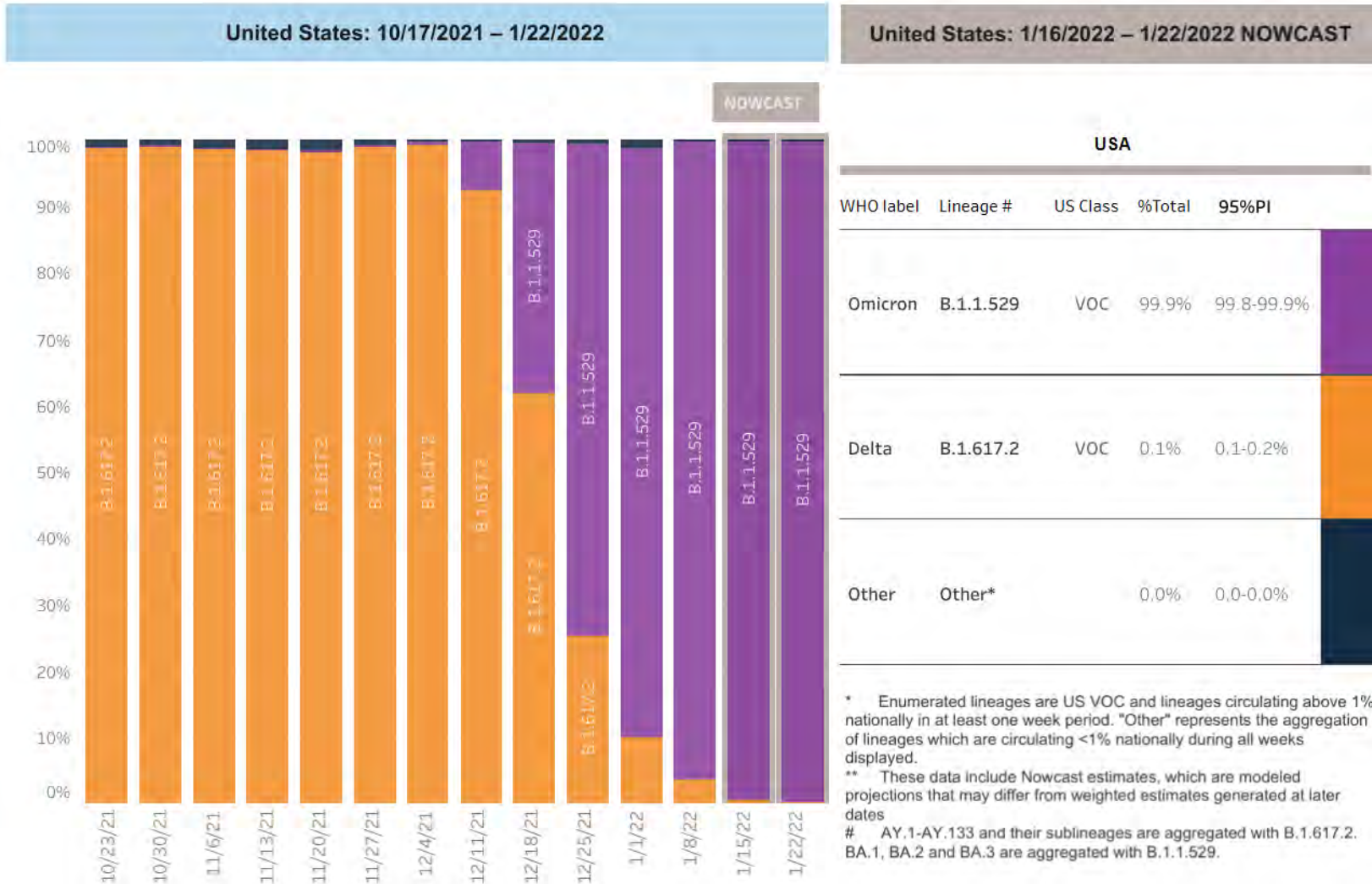

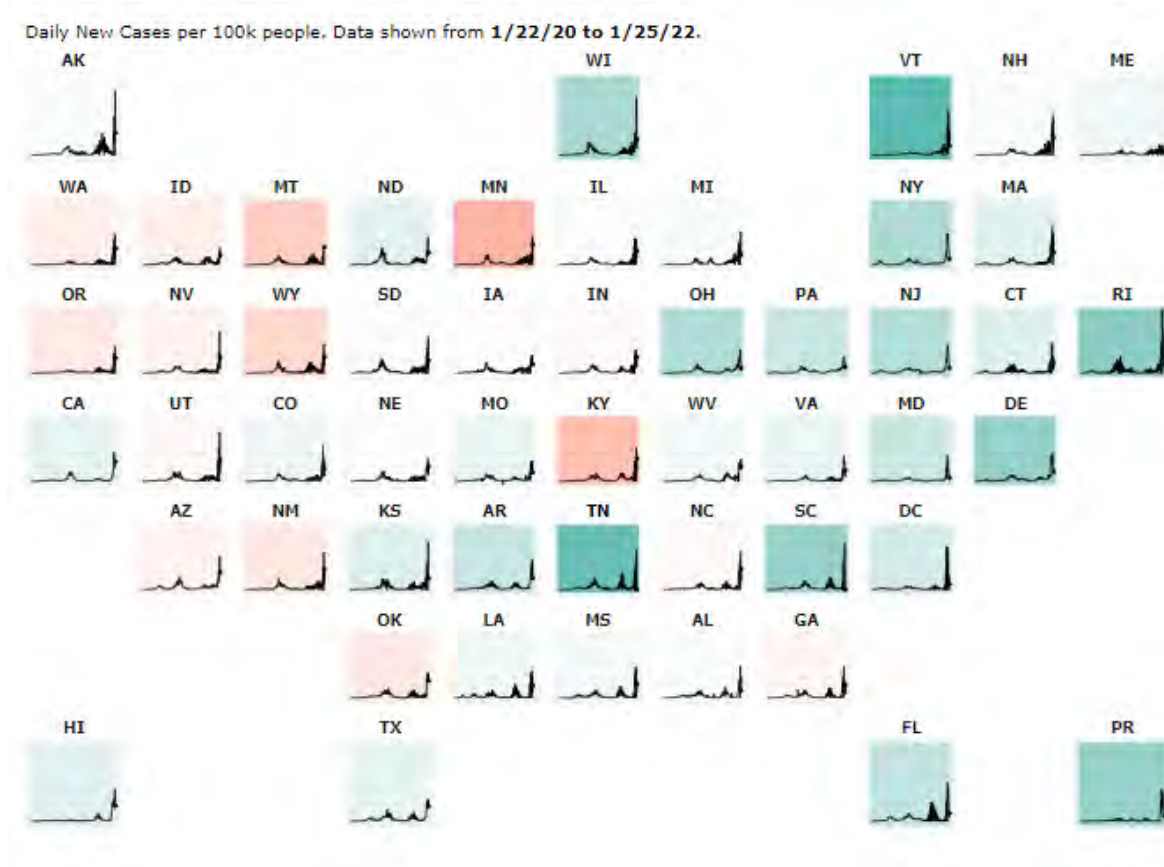


Omicron in the US

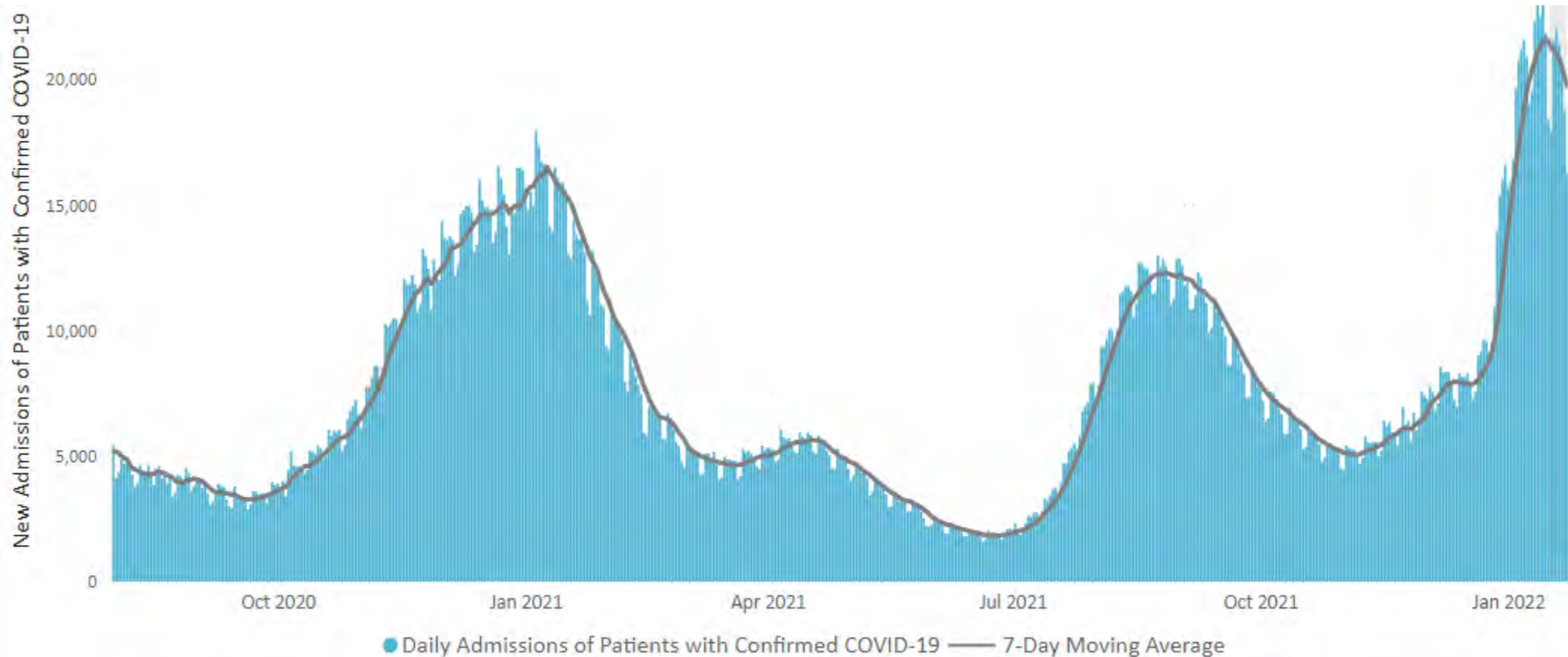
Reported Cases Decreasing in Many States

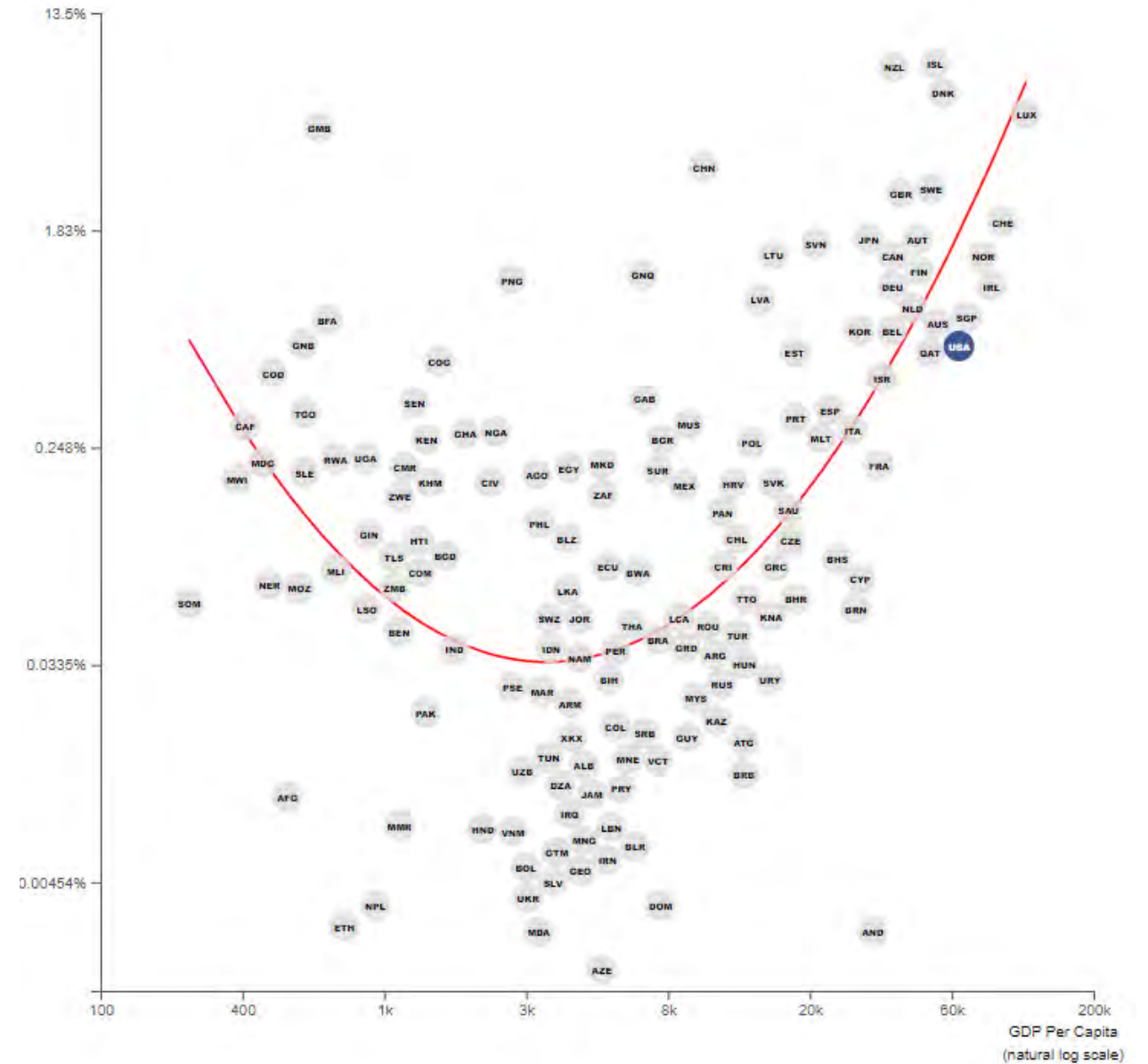

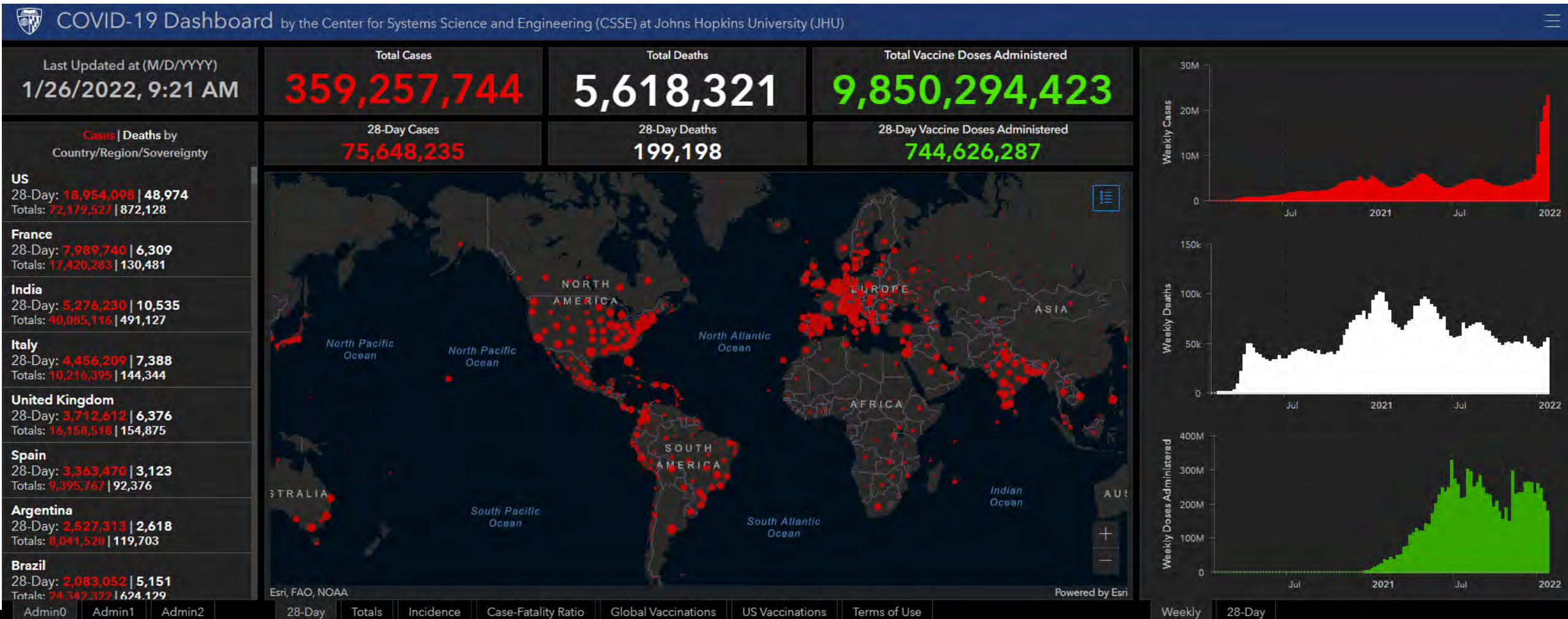
Tracking Variants

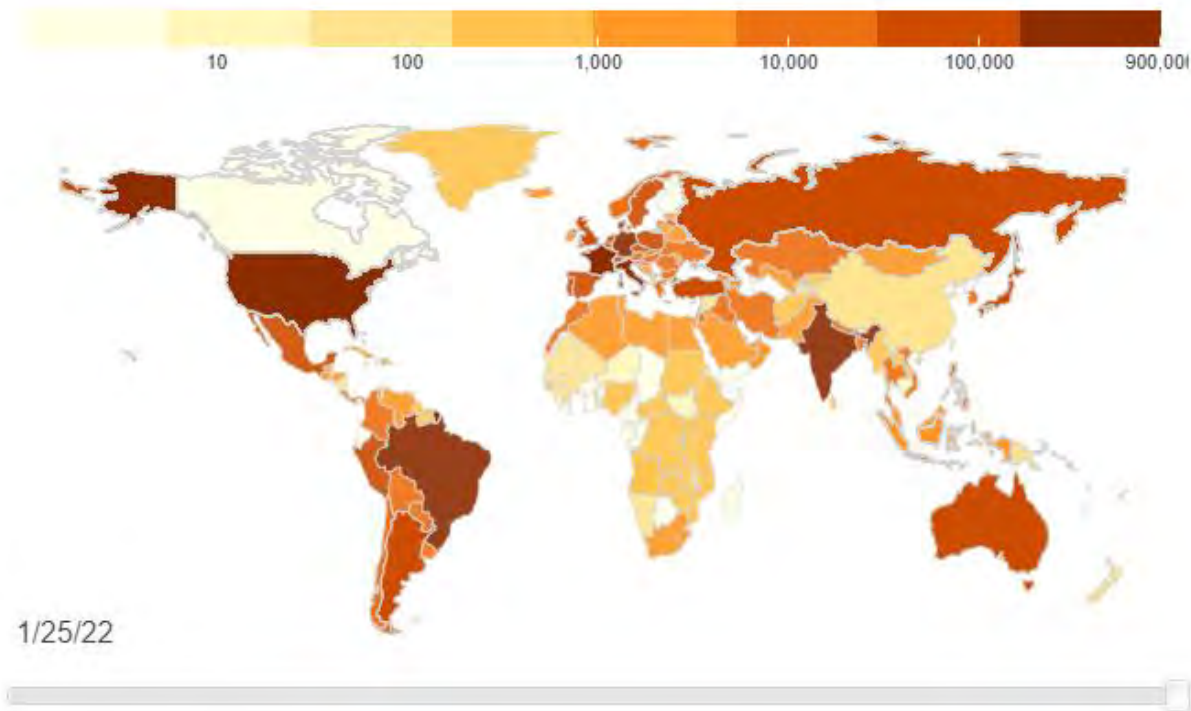

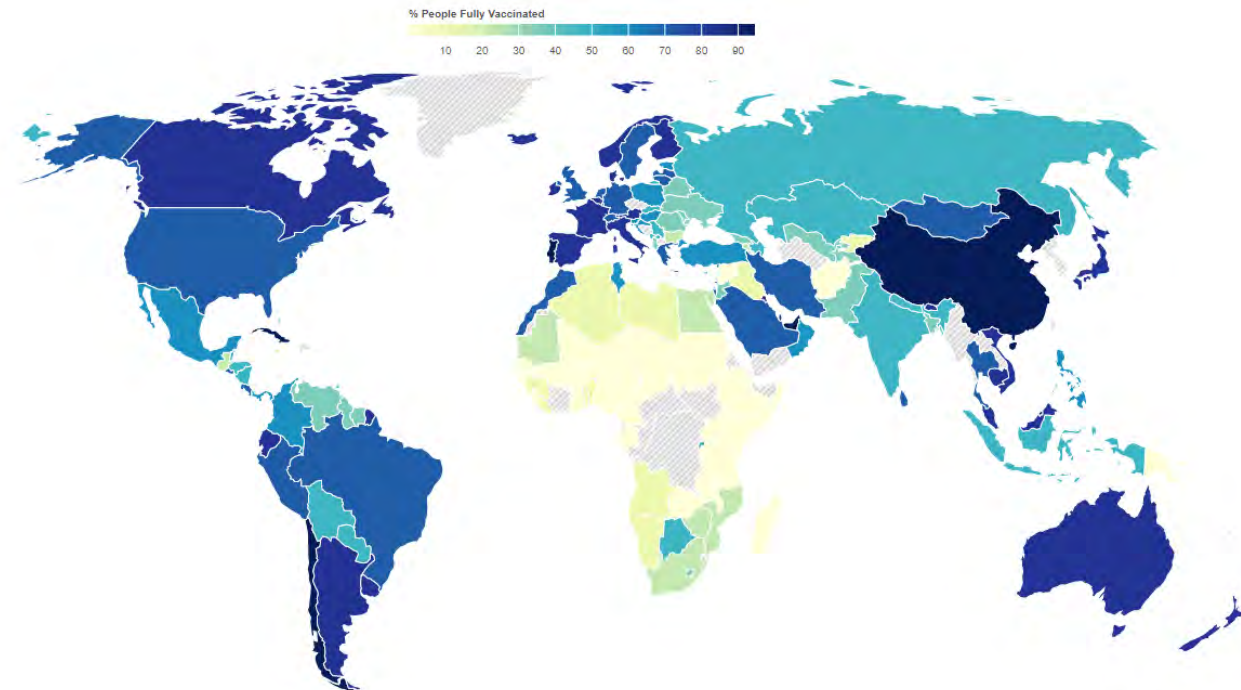
Global Spread, Vaccine Inequity Persist
